## **County Burn Rules**

Burning in our dry, windy climate is very dangerous. You can be cited and held liable for damages caused by fire that escapes your control. You can obtain burning information at <a href="https://www.sandovalcountynm.gov/fire/open-burning-info">www.sandovalcountynm.gov/fire/open-burning-info</a>. Most types of burning require a permit. An alternative for getting rid of dead brush, weeds or tumbleweeds is to bag them and take them to the **Sandoval County Landfill** located in Rio Rancho or have your trash service remove the bags.
